ANITA WILLIAMS (DBA) BRANSON OUTREACH is a respected professional, and she has spent the past 5 years building a positive reputation. We have been informed that you have that you have been maliciously spreading inaccurate and unfounded information that is damaging to her personal and professional character.

Under defamation laws in this jurisdiction, it is unlawful for an individual to make deliberate statements that intend to harm the reputation of another party without factual evidence or based on hearsay.
